CONFERENCE VENUE

The conference will be held at the Columbia Metropolitan Convention Center, located at 1101 Lincoln St in Columbia, SC. The CMCC parking lot adjacent to the facility may be available at no charge on a first-come, first-served basis. Pay-for-Parking garages and metered parking is also available.

CONFERENCE HOTEL
